**HOWARD B. MARLER** was a professional photographer in northern Virginia and Washington DC for more than half-a-century, producing countless photos of Washington-area people, events, places, scenes, celebrities and more. A World War II Navy veteran and lifelong flying enthusiast, Howard Marler enjoyed nothing more than taking his camera aloft on sunny days, to capture stunning aerial images of our fast-developing region. His aerial views depict long-ago landmarks, and document the many changes taking place. (*Imagine* a world when one could just grab a camera and fly above Washington DC, taking pictures of everything.) But that's not all. Over his 50-year career, Howard Marler also delighted in acquiring photograph collections from many other sources. By the time he died, in 2005, his vast accumulated treasure-trove of slides, prints, negatives, transparencies, postcards and collected images numbered over *one-million items* --- depicting *real* history, as it actually looked through the camera lens --- from the 1880s to the 1990s.

**SPEAKER:** **Helen Marler**, daughter of the photographer, is curator of the **Howard Marler Museum**. A published author who has spoken all over the country, she has been featured in magazines and newspapers. She founded **The Living History Company** in 1993 to teach our history in a unique way. Dressed in authentic period garb, Helen will take us on an interactive "*Journey of Discovery*" across a century of Washington-area history, using images and stories from our past --- touching old memories, and reminding us of the way things once were . . . and could be again.

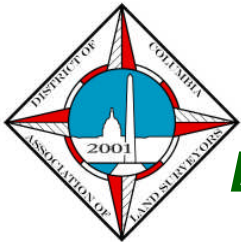
